#### **Ask the Birds**

If birds could offer advice on human problems, what would they say? Artists Marcus Coates and Fiona MacDonald: Feral Practice, with an esteemed panel of bird specialists: Helen Macdonald, Tim Birkhead and Ceri Levy, apply their knowledge of bird life to help illuminate problems and questions of human experience. The panel will use their specialist knowledge of the intricate relationships and behaviours that have evolved amongst bird species as a mirror to our own lives, opening up fresh perspectives and insights.
